#### **Level 3 End of Season Open Meet Rules & Conditions**

- 1. The meet will be held under Swim England laws and regulations and Swim England technical rules of racing and these conditions.
- 2. All entrants must be Club Compete members of an affiliated Club as defined by SE Law. SE Registration numbers must be included on the entry form.
- 3. There are no Upper or Lower limit qualifying times. However, any swimmer who has qualified for a National or British Champs competition in 2023 may not enter this competition in the event for which they qualified.
- 4. Swimmers with classifications (S Categories) and those who require additional provisions to access the event are requested to notify the Meet Manager in advance of the meet. Disabilities must be reported to the referee before the session of their event. A copy of their Swim England certificate of permanent disability must be produced. Failure to comply could result in disqualification from their events. A secondary strobe light will be available.
- 5. Entries with Short Course times (long course conversions accepted) should be submitted using Hy-Tek Team Manager software for more than 3 swimmers, along with the club entry summary & coach pass application form together with entry fees. These should reach the meet secretary by <u>1st July 2023 by email to competition@swindondolphin.co.uk</u>. Cheques will no longer be accepted.

The entry fee is £6.50 per event. Coach passes are £15 each.

- 6. The correct entry fee must accompany the entries, or they will be treated as incorrect.
- 7. Age groups are 9, 10, 11, 12/13, 14/15, 16 & Over, ages at 23rd July 2023. All events are heat declared winners and medals will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> placed swimmers in each age group. Unfortunately awards not collected will not be posted.
- 8. All results will be available on meet mobile and sent by email at the end of the Competition.
- 9. If events are over-subscribed, the promoter reserves the right to return entries based on first come first served basis, the latest received entries will be rejected.
- 10. Late entries will only be accepted after the advertised closing date if there is sufficient space or empty lanes. Day of event entries will only be accepted if there has been an administrative error.
- 11. No refunds will be made to competitors who withdraw after advice of acceptance without a doctor's certificate.
- 12. The promoter reserves the right to refuse admission to <u>any competitor or spectator</u> who displays or has previously displayed rude, aggressive, or abusive behaviour.
- 13. Only competitors, officials and holders of a valid coaches pass will be permitted on poolside.

- 14. Start list for each event will be sent directly to the stewards in the marshalling area for distribution to the coaches.
- 15. Entries will be seeded into heats from submitted times and the slowest heats swum first. The heats in each event will be spearheaded.
- 16. Competitors must report to the marshals, one event before their own and must remain in the marshalling area until called to compete. For the first event at the start of each session, competitors should report to the marshals at the end of the warm up. Failure to do so may mean exclusion from the event.
- 17. All starts will be at the deep end of the pool. All starts will be over the top, except backstroke races.
- 18. During warm up, swimmers must be supervised by their coach. A warm up protocol will be issued with each coaches information pack and coaches are required to ensure that their swimmers adhere to the warm up procedure as outlined in the protocol or they may be requested to leave the pool.
- 19. All competitors are required to observe all safety announcements and conduct themselves in an appropriate manner at all times.
- 20. Anyone wishing to use a devices capable of photography or video recording must take careful note of the information posters. The full ASA Guidance on Photography can be found in Wavepower the SE Child Safeguarding Policy and Procedures available at <a href="https://www.swimming.org">www.swimming.org</a>
- 21. Under extenuating circumstances which are out of our control, the Referee reserves the right to amend or change the meet rules on the day to cover all conditions out of his/her control to ensure the smooth running of the competition.
- 22. Swimmer entries will be managed electronically. By submitting entries, consent is thereby given, as required by the Data Protection Act 2018, to the holding of personal information electronically. Personal data will be available for inspection during the meet upon request and will be stored and destroyed in accordance with Swim England guidelines. The data you provide will be processed for the purposes of running the Meet, including seeding, programme (online and printed), results, management of officials and management of child protection poolside. You agree that we may publish your (or your club members) personal information as part of the programme and results of the Meet and may pass such information to the governing body or any affiliated organisation.
- 23. Competitors are advised not to leave their belongings unattended. Neither the Promoter, Swindon Dolphin ASC nor the Link Centre will accept responsibility for any property that may be lost, stolen or damaged.
- 24. If possible, clubs are requested to provide a licenced official / time keeper for every 8 swimmers entered. Names and contact details will be requested once a club's entry has been received entries will not be refused if this is not possible and the meet promoter will endeavour to ensure there are sufficient officials / timekeepers to meet the license requirements for each session. If this proves not to be possible for a session, times from that session will not be submitted to the SE rankings. Please sign up using the link <a href="Swim-Meet">Swim-Meet</a>
