Promoters Conditions

General Conditions

1. The meet will be held under Swim England (SE) Laws and Regulations and SE Technical Rules of Racing and has been licensed at Level 2 by SE so that times achieved can qualify for county, regional and national competitions. Licence Number 2SW262366.
2. Any situation not covered by these conditions will either be referred to the lead referee or Meet Promoter. The outcome of any decision will be based on SE Law or Technical Rules or in the spirit of fairness and equity and will be announced accordingly.

Entries

3. All competitors must be Club Compete members of an affiliated club, eligible to compete and registered in accordance with **Swim England** laws and technical rules and may enter in the name of one club only
4. Swimmers with classifications. The Competition will be run as an integrated competition. Para-Swim/Disability competitors must have an authorised SE/IPC Swimming Classification, or Certificate of Disability/Exception which must be declared on the entry form and be presented to the Referee at the start of the relevant session before racing commences. Failure to do so may result in disqualification. A secondary strobe light will be available, please contact the meet promoter should you require this.
5. Swimmers will be required to swim in one of two groups, Female or Open/Male swimmers. The Female category is for birth sex females in accordance with Swim England's Transgender and Non-Binary competition policy for swimming. By entering the 'Female' category, a swimmer confirms that their birth sex is female.
6. **The entry fee is £8.50 per individual event**
7. Age Groups for the meet are based on age on the 31st December 2026.
8. Entries must meet the published minimum qualifying standards for age and gender and all such entries will be considered. All entry times must be verified from the GB Aquatics Rankings - www.swimmingresults.org
9. **All entries of more than three swimmers must be submitted as a HyTek entry file, available to download from the website: Open Meets | swindondolphin. Please submit entries to Teri Newton – competition@swindondolphinasc.co.uk**
10. Entries may be restricted to keep the session times within the appropriate time scales and to allow for limits on the maximum numbers allowable poolside. The acceptance of competitors will be based on fastest times submitted by age group. Details of accepted and rejected entries will be notified as soon as possible after the closing date. Rejected entries will be refunded.
11. If the meet is oversubscribed, a reserve list will be operated to insulate against the effect of late withdrawals and to maximise opportunities for swimmers to participate. Swimmers whose entries are initially rejected will be invited to apply for inclusion on the reserve list. Anyone on the reserve list must be within the qualifying times. The period for application will close five days after publication of the initial list of accepted and rejected entries. The reserve list will be seeded based on a first come first served basis. If swims become available, they will be offered to those highest on the reserve list. Swims for those accepted reserve applicants cannot be guaranteed. Entry fees from reserves that do not swim at the Meet will be refunded after the Meet.
12. Poolside passes are £20 each for the whole meet and must be requested at least two weeks before the meet. Passes are transferable, but we ask clubs to ensure they are only held by registered members with an up-to-date DBS check. Passes must be worn at all times when poolside. Clubs will normally be restricted to a maximum of four poolside passes, but a club should contact the Meet Promoter if this will be insufficient to manage their swimmers.
13. All teams must be accompanied by at least one Swim England Coach or the equivalent Level 2 coach who must have current Safeguarding and DBS passes. Team Managers on poolside must be TM1 qualified and be DBS checked. All clubs will comply with the Swim England Team Manager, Coach and Chaperone Policy.

14. By submitting entries on the official entry forms and Hy-Tek, clubs and competitors accept the rules of this competition. Competitors whose entries are accepted and subsequently found to have been entered in the wrong event(s) because of incorrect entry information will be withdrawn from the event(s) and will not have their entry fees refunded. However, if because of error by the organiser, the error will be corrected and the entry accepted.
15. All data relating to the entry and results processing will be held on a computer using Hy-Tek Meet Manager System software. Results of the meet will be sent to Swim England as soon as possible after the meet. Swimmer entries will be managed electronically. By submitting entries, consent is thereby given, as required by the Data Protection Act 2018, to the holding of personal information electronically. Personal data will be available for inspection during the meet upon request and will be stored and destroyed in accordance with Swim England guidelines. You agree that we may publish your (or your club members) personal information as part of the programme and results of the Meet and may pass such information to the governing body or any affiliated organisation.
16. Please submit entries by **10pm on Friday 30th October 2026**.
17. If on Friday 30th October insufficient entries have been received for the meet to be financially viable, the meet will be cancelled. In these, or any other circumstances necessitating cancellation of the meet, we will aim to refund all entry fees, but reserve the right to retain sufficient funds to cover any costs unavoidably incurred.
18. Short Course (25m) entry times or converted long course time will be accepted.
19. No refunds for entries will be given after the entries have been processed and accepted, except in the case of medical withdrawals notified before the meet commences and with the production of either a doctor or medical certificate or an email from the swimmer's Head Coach confirming the athlete is unfit to compete. Refunds in these circumstances will be processed post meet once the appropriate certification has been received by the Meet Promoter. It is the responsibility of the entrant to then provide a summary of events entered by the withdrawing athlete along with a bank account name, Account number and sort code into which the refund is to be made.

Payments

20. We will request payments once entries have been closed and processed. If payments are not received before the commencement of the meet a £10 admin fee will be added. BACS Payment:

Officials

21. All visiting clubs are requested to **provide one qualified and licensed official for every 8 swimmers entered in each session**. The meet promoter will endeavour to ensure there are sufficient officials to meet the licence requirements for each session. If this proves not to be possible for a session, times from that session may be subject to a lower licence grading, or will not be submitted to the Swim England rankings.
22. Qualified officials who officiate at any of the four sessions will be entitled to mileage expenses at a rate of 45p per mile from their home address to the pool venue and return, with a limit of one claim per day, regardless of the number of sessions attended that day. Officials should request an expenses application form from a Referee, which should be completed and returned to the Referee during the duration of the Meet.

24. Officials will be provided with refreshments before the start of each day, and lunch in between sessions on each day.

The Competition

25. The Competition will be swum Short Course. Anti-wave devices will be in place and electronic timing/placing must be used. The Organiser reserves the right to ban the use of gas hooters, klaxons etc, which in the organisers opinion, could be a hazard or a danger to swimmers, officials or spectators.
26. All events will be run on a Heat Declared Winner basis, Entries will be seeded from submitted times: the slowest heats being swum first. All heats will be placed in 'spearhead' formation.
27. Medals will be given to the top 3 swimmers in each gender / age group category, The age groups are 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 and 16 + years. Separate medals in each age group category will be awarded to disability swimmers using British Paralympic Points.
28. All swimmers must go to marshalling when asked to do so or may be excluded from the event.
29. Backstroke starting ledges will be used at this meet.
30. All starts will be at the deep end of the pool. All starts will be over the top, except Backstroke races.
31. A secondary starting strobe is available. Please will swimmers requiring the secondary strobe indicate this on entering.
32. During warm up, swimmers must be supervised by their coach. A warm up protocol will be issued with each coaches information pack and coaches are required to ensure their swimmers adhere to the warm up procedure as outlined in the protocol or they may be requested to leave the pool.

Conduct During the Meet

33. Swindon Dolphin ASC Swimming Club are not responsible for swimmers from other clubs. Coaches and Team Managers are responsible for the conduct and safety of their swimmers. Coaches must adhere to the safety advice from the warm up stewards. The promoter reserves the right to exclude any persons from the meet at any time, who display inappropriate language or behaviour. This includes, but is not limited to, swimmers' coaches or spectators.
34. Only competitors, officials and holders of a valid coaches pass will be permitted on poolside.
35. The safety rules of the pool must be adhered to at all times, Anyone not adhering to these rules (which will be read out at the start of each session) may be removed from the pool.
36. Anyone wishing to use a camera, mobile phone camera, or video camera, should adhere to the Swim England guidelines on the use of images and restrict focus on their own child for their own private use with no posting on social media or similar platforms. You are reminded that Flash photograph is NOT permitted at the start of any heat. 37. **The use of any device with video or photo capture capability are strictly prohibited in the toilets, changing rooms or changing area's at any time. Strict sanctions will be imposed if this rule is broken.** If any participant is seen to be holding or using any such device in the changing area, they will be immediately removed from the remainder of the meet & no refunds given. Furthermore, the incident will be reported to Swim England&/or their Club for further action in line with swim England's safeguarding policy
38. Under extenuating circumstances which are out of our control, the Referee reserves the right to amend or change the meet rules on the day to cover all conditions out of his/her control to ensure the smooth running of the competition.
39. Competitors are advised not to leave their belongings unattended. Neither the Promoter, Swindon Dolphin ASC nor Bath University will accept responsibility for any property that may be lost, stolen or damaged.
